What do you need to do?

- Register to participate
- Promote the event via newsletters, mailings and social media
- Volunteer in stores on September 20th. Your volunteers can:
 - Man the PTA /Fill the Bus information table as shoppers enter the store;
 - Assist cashiers with bagging groceries;
 - Bring your school's mascot to help promote PTA; or
 - Provide entertainment (after school hours) with small music / performance groups from your school (musicians, cheerleaders, sports team members, etc.)

ELIGIBILITY

1. **PTA / PTSA must be a Unit in Good Standing** with Virginia PTA (VA PTA) and Fairfax County Council of PTAs (FCCPTA) as of August 31, 2017:
 - Current Officer Information Sheet received by VA PTA & FCCPTA
 - Membership Dues received for 2016- 17 school year (both VA PTA and FCCPTA dues must be paid)
 - Audit on file for 2015- 2016 school year
 - Copy of IRS 990 for 2015- 16 for 2015 – 2016 school year
 - Bylaws are current

2. **PTA President must authorize** Local Unit PTA to participate in this program by completing the online application at <https://goo.gl/kwwSMK>. Upon acceptance of your application, you will receive a link to a signup genius. Volunteer spots are available on a first come first serve basis. Please sign up for only those volunteer spots that your PTA can commit to.

3. **PTA / PTSA must promote the FCCPTA Whole Foods 5% Day flyer among its membership.** FCCPTA will share the Whole Foods 5% Day flyer in both a PDF and JPEG format. FCCPTA should be copied on any electronic communication for verification. This must be shared in at least two of the following ways:
 - In an email distribution or electronic PTA / PTSA newsletter;
 - Hard copy sent home with parents;
 - Share the FCCPTA Facebook graphic on your PTA / PTSA Facebook page or group;
 - Retweet the FCCPTA Tweet on your PTA / PTSA Twitter account;

4. **PTA / PTSA must provide volunteers at a Whole Foods location** (see locations on front of this form) for a two hour shift. Volunteers can help bag groceries, attend to the PTA promotion table to promote the benefits of PTA in the community, etc. Tell the shoppers about the great things YOUR PTA does for your school community. **PTA / PTSA members are encouraged to wear a PTA / PTSA or school shirt of their choice to promote that they are representing a PTA.** PTA / PTSA volunteers must register in advance to volunteer using the Signup Genius Link which will be provided upon successful registration.

5. **The maximum amount payable to any one PTA /PTSA is \$500.** Checks will be made payable to local unit PTA/PTSA within 30 days of FCCPTA’s receipt of funds from Whole Foods. Expect payment in mid- November.
